

Rogue Dog Training's Vaccine Requirements to Attend Group Classes

In order to attend Rogue Dog Training's Puppy Socialization and Group Obedience Classes, puppies and adult dogs need to have at least one series of DHPP combo vaccination one week prior to the first class, will need to have received their Rabies vaccination if the dog is older than 4 months, and at least one Bordetella vaccine depending on the route of administration.

In addition to the DHPP, Rabies, and Bordetella requirement **we strongly recommend having your puppy vaccinated for parainfluenza. This is typically included in your Distemper vaccine or DHPP.** We recommend speaking with your Veterinarian about the 'pros' and 'cons' of each vaccination.

Rogue Dog Training also accepts Vaccination Titers with a written summary from your Veterinarian

1 year later	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Rabies
every 3 years thereafter	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Distemper, Adenovirus 2 (Hepatitis), Parainfluenza, Parvovirus - DHPP
every 3 years thereafter	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Rabies

Common diseases with vaccines available:

- Distemper - an airborne viral disease of the lungs, intestines and brain
- Parvovirus - a viral disease of the intestines
- Parainfluenza - infectious bronchitis
- Hepatitis - a viral disease of the liver caused by canine adenovirus
- Rabies - a viral disease fatal to humans and other animals
- Bordatella - a bacterial infection of the upper respiratory system (kennel cough)
- Leptospirosis - a bacterial disease of the urinary tract
- Corona - a viral disease of the intestines
